Arkansas Baptist College needs information from you to process your Financial Aid Award.

You did not indicate on your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) that you received a high school diploma, a GED certificate or were home schooled. Receipt of a high school diploma (or home school equivalent), or GED is required to receive federal and state financial aid.

- **If you graduated from a U.S. high school and received a high school diploma:** have your high school send a certified and sealed copy of your transcript to the ABC Office of Admissions, 1621 Dr. Martin Luther King Drive Little Rock, AR 72202. If you graduated from a high school in a foreign country and received the equivalent of a U.S high school diploma: provide official documentation to the ABC Office of Admissions. Contact their office at 501-420-1232 for more information on the type of documentation they will accept.
- **If you earned a GED certificate:** have your passing GED test scores sent from your state's education department to the ABC Office of Admissions, 1621 Dr. Martin Luther King Drive Little Rock, AR 72202.
- **If you were home-schooled:** you need to either meet ABC's admission standards for home-schooled students or have received a state-issued "secondary school completion credential" from a state other than Arkansas. Home-school documentation needs to be submitted to the ABC Office of Admissions, 1621 Dr. Martin Luther King Drive Little Rock, AR 72202.
- **If you have successfully completed at least a two-year program that is acceptable for full credit toward a bachelor's degree, or you have successfully completed a bachelor's degree:** have your prior school send a certified and sealed copy of your degree transcript to the ABC Office of Admissions, 1621 Dr. Martin Luther King Drive Little Rock, AR 72202.

Due to changes in the Federal Student Aid Programs, an "Ability to Benefit" Test is no longer an option for students who first enroll in college on or after July 1, 2012. However, if you first enrolled in college prior to July 1, 2012, you may be eligible for federal student aid if you can document one of the following:

- If you have taken and passed an approved "Ability-to- Benefit" Test: submit a certified copy of your passing test scores to the Office of Student Financial Aid and Scholarships, 1621 Dr. Martin Luther King Drive Little Rock, AR 72202.
- If you have passed a minimum of 6 college credits prior to July 1, 2012: have your prior school send a certified and sealed copy of your transcript to the ABC Office of Admissions, 1621 Dr. Martin Luther King Drive Little Rock, AR 72202.

IMPORTANT: Once you have completed one of the options above, please submit this form to the Office of Student Financial Aid and Scholarships indicating which option you completed. Once we confirm this information, we will continue to process your financial aid award.
