RESPONSIBILITIES: Teach 12 undergraduate criminal justice hours per semester, serve as academic advisor to the Social & Behavioral Sciences majors, hold office hours, and other responsibilities as assigned.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Criminal Justice

A degree in criminal justice with a minimum of 18 graduate hours. Prior teaching experience(s) a plus. An earned doctorate degree is preferred (ABDs will be considered).

BEGINNING DATE: Fall 2017 semester

A complete application packet must include a letter of application, curriculum vita, master and doctorate transcripts, and contact information for three references (official transcripts, three letter of recommendations, and a completed ABC Application for Employment will be required for the successful candidate after the individual is selected). Applications will be reviewed beginning February 2017.
